At Mamaway Wiidokdaadwin, we take Covid-19 seriously & follow all recommended steps to keep each other safe, such as wearing masks, washing hands often, keeping a safe distance when possible & staying informed.

Covid Vaccines

All Indigenous people 12 years of age or older can book an appointment to receive the COVID-19 vaccine. The time between Dose 1 and Dose 2 is 21 days for adults and 28 days minimum for youth.

Mamaway Wiidokdaadwin is supporting clinics in the community, but we are NOT offering the vaccine in our clinic offices at this time.
